## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR MANUSCRIPTS**

Controlled Experiments are NOT Required. Detailed Studies ARE Required

THE SOURCE OF ALL BIOLOGICAL MATERIAL MUST BE CLEARLY DEFINED as to where it came from, how it was collected and purified, how it's content was analyzed and verified, how it was stored.

Because the **Journal of the Drake Biomedical Institute** is an electronic journal, manuscripts should be submitted in electronic form. It is preferred that manuscripts be submitted in PDF form (portable document format) via e-mail. RTF and TXT files are also accepted. All images of tables, diagrams, figures, photos etc. INCLUDING THEIR LEGENDS, should be in PDF or JPEG format only. Manuscripts not in electronic format, but otherwise ready for printing and in excellent condition for scanning, will also be accepted on a case by case basis; however, their submission to peer review will be slower due to handling time in converting to electronic format. Papers not submitted electronically may be additionally considered for presentation in a Review. Please follow these additional instructions:

**(A) Subject:** Only reports relating to human patients treated with stem cells, stem cell related treatments, or hormonal treatments of disease or beneficial effects on quality of life will be accepted.

**(B) Basic form of the report:** Manuscripts should follow the standard format for biomedical journals, which is:

- \* Title
- \* Authors
- \* Authors' complete address and contact information including Hospital, Institute, Research Center, or University, address, phone, fax, e-mail.
- \* Summary
- \* Introduction
- \* Materials and Methods, including patient details and tests, and in particular detailing the source of stem cell or hormonal material, preparation techniques
- \* Results
- \* Discussion

- \* Conclusion
- \* No Footnotes are permitted. An important note can be included in References.
- \* References

**(C) Language:** Manuscripts must be in English. For international submissions, please have your paper translated into English. The Editors may, where appropriate or possible, clean up your English translation. Reports in a foreign language may also be considered PROVIDED that a detailed English Abstract is included.

**(D) References:** Arrange alphabetically by author and follow standard reference reporting:

*Article in Periodical or Journal:* Testa, G., Borghese, L., Steinbeck, J. A., and Brustle, O. Breakdown of the Potentiality Principle and Its Impact on Global Stem Cell Research. **Cell Stem Cell (2007) 1:153-156.**

*Article in a Book:* Abramoff, P. and La Vie, M.F.P., in **Biology of the Immune Response**, McGraw-Hill Book Co., New York, (1970), p.136.
